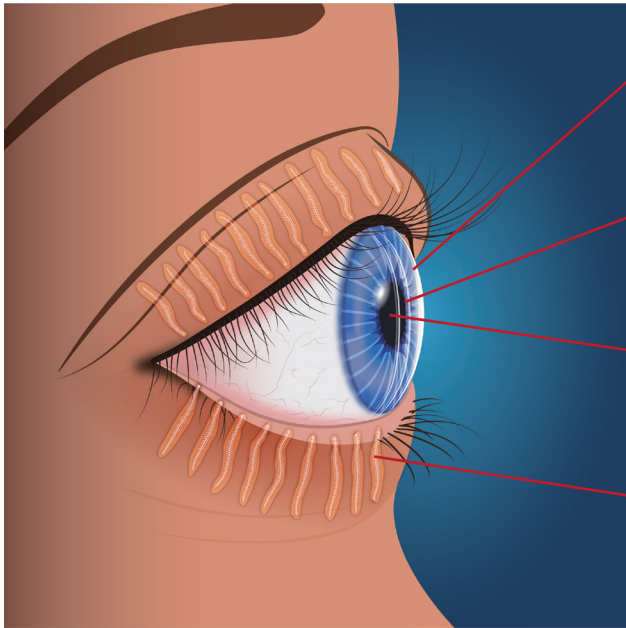


Anatomy of Tear Film and Meibomian Glands



Lipid (oil) layer:

lubricates and prevents evaporation

Aqueous (water) layer:

nourishes and protects the cornea

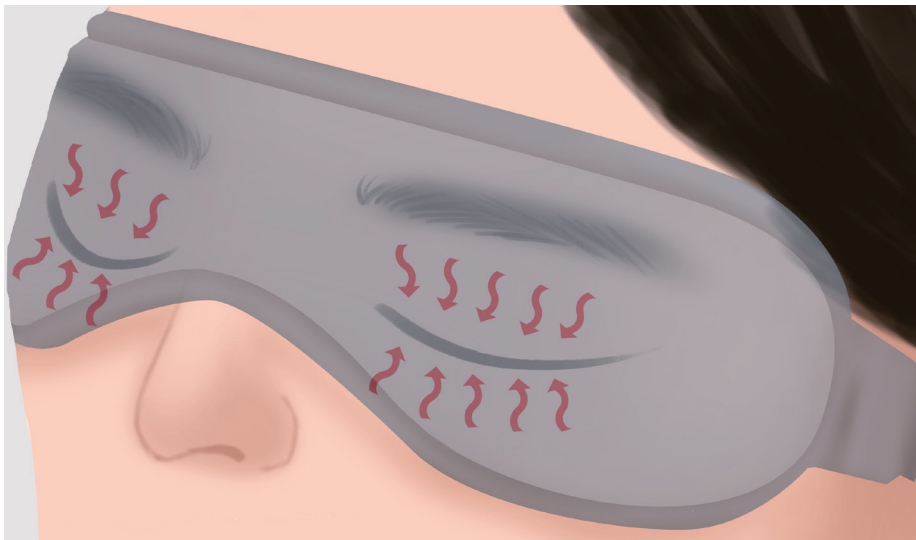
Mucin layer:

adheres tears to the eye

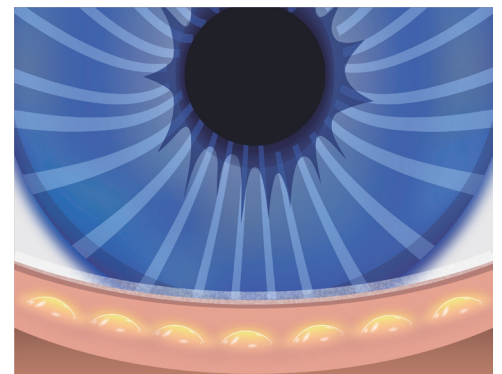
Meibomian glands:

create the lipid (oil) layer of the tear film, a **blockage** can lead to evaporative **dry eye**

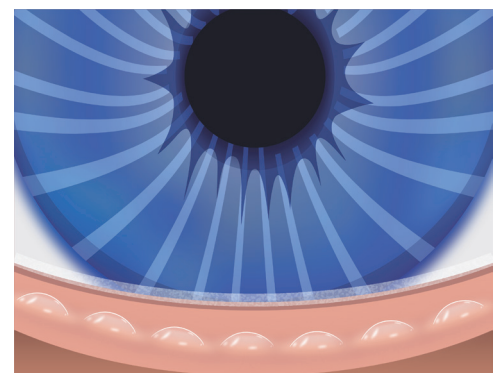
Use iFlo to Relieve Meibomian Gland Dysfunction



iFlo dry eye mask heats upper and lower eyelids precisely to soften blocked oil inside meibomian glands. After heating, blink eyes hard to squeeze the yellowish oil and the healthy clear oil will flow naturally again.
